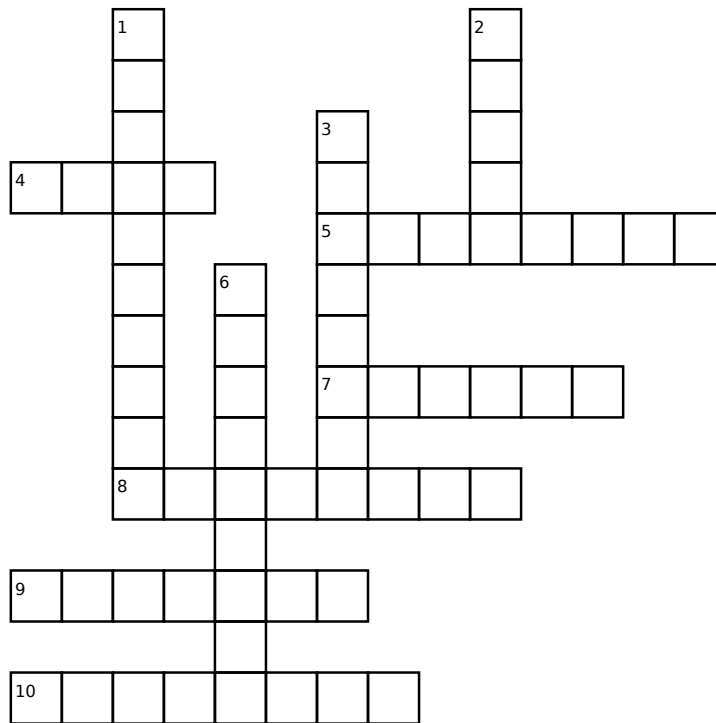


Chapter 3 Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle - Reading 5/Hayden
